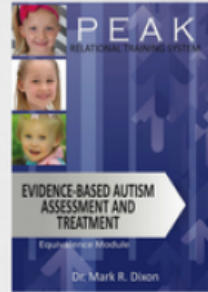

- **Evidence-Based**

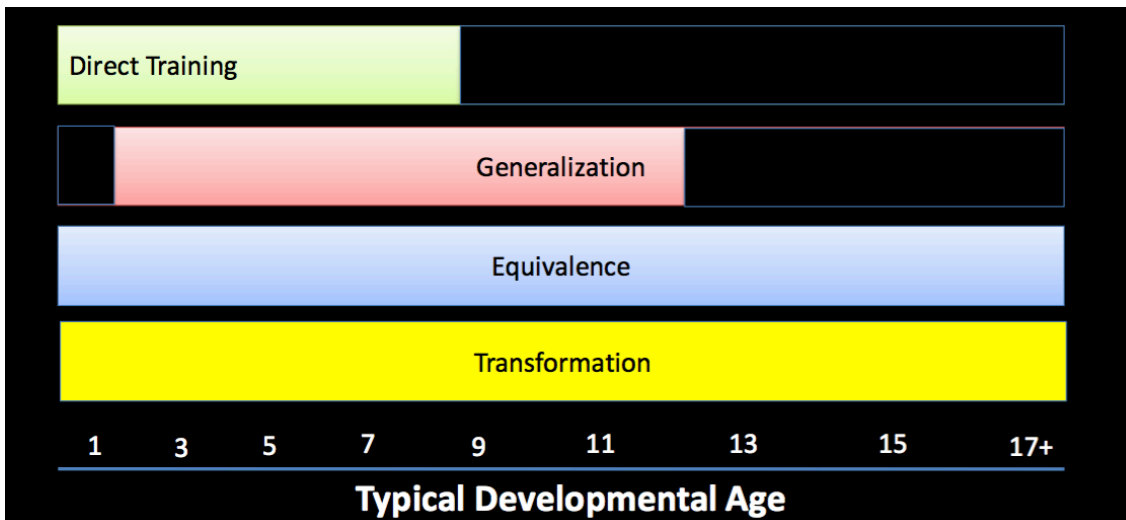
- PEAK has 25 papers published in peer-reviewed journals supporting its effectiveness, including a randomized-control trial
